**Registration:** The First Contact to SHRMP. Be Polite, Smile.; Responsible for maintaining the registration forms for the site they are working; Filling out each child's name tag; Assigning kids to there perspective crew leader; Completing daily reports for the site; Keeper of the Crew Leader's role at the end of the day and making any necessary updates; Often administering band-aids to minor scraps; Make sure your registration bin is in bus/vehicle before you leave to go to a site. Return to SHRMP headquarters at the end of each site.

**Crew Leaders:** Crew Leaders take kids from one SHRMP rotation to the next; Crew Leaders are usually the ones who develop a bond with the kids and often have the opportunity to witness to the kids; Pray with kids.

**Bible Story:** Tell the stories; Make it interesting. Add some Drama; Be creative; Add some Props; Be prepared; Do not come and just read the story, act it out; Relate to the kids; Get the kids involved.

**Recreation:** Playing Games with the kids; Get all kids involved; Be creative; Have Fun; Be Cheerful; Be Gentle; Make sure YOU have your equipment for whatever rec you are doing that day. Also return all equipment back to the church at end of each site and place back in rec room.

**Crafts:** Doing crafts assigned to each day; Make sure YOU load your crafts and supplies needed for that day into the bus/vehicle; Make sure all kids get the opportunity to do the craft each day; Place their names on their craft and give to Crew Leaders to hold until the end of the day; Cleanup and return leftovers to bus/vehicle and then into the building.

**Worship Leaders:** Know the Songs and Motions; Responsible for picking the music for each site and the CDs. Make sure you keep track of your CDs; Make sure YOU have your sound equipment at each site; Communication with Site Leader. Keep to schedule; Be Punctual. After initial prayer, be prepared to start music to get kids enthused; Be Flexible. If you notice kids are not reacting to certain songs, change it up; Make sure all equipment is returned to the building at the end of the site; Be prepared to do songs without music if need be.

**Music Teachers:** Make sure YOU have your CD players, CDs and batteries; Know the moves to the songs; Teach each class a different song; Have Fun, Enjoy the music, assist the kids and SMILE; return music and CDs to building after each site.

**Reading Program:** Each child will have a one on one reading time with volunteers. These kids do not have this closeness at home and some need help with reading. Adults will be available for severe reading difficulties. Books are available for kids to take home and keep.

# SHRMP 2016 DRESS CODE & REQUIREMENTS

Please do not forget your sleeping bag and/or air mattress and other sleeping needs.

**Name tags** are essential as they identify *SHRMP volunteer* to other individuals. They should be worn at all times.

There is to be **NO PDA** (Public Display of Affection).

Use of excessive makeup should be avoided due to the fact that we will be working outside in the heat. Strong fragrances should also be avoided due to a individuals with Asthma.

Remember when dressing it will be very hot and humid. You may be most comfortable in loose fitting cotton clothing. Clothing must be modest and conservative.

Please do not wear flashy or expensive jewelry. **This includes Cell Phones. They are NOT to be on sites unless you are an Adult leader.**

Please remember to bring hats, sunglasses and sunscreen for sun protection, as well as insect repellent and lotions.

Before Departing on Saturday after SHRMP week everyone is expected to assist in the cleaning of the church and storing of all supplies in designated locations. *If you are leaving early any night please have your ride pick you up by 10pm. Building will be secured after that time.*

**All** individuals will be placed on the cleaning schedule. Please check with your youth leader for designated time slots and make sure your designated area is cleaned on your rotation. Please keep sleeping area clean. Please pick up all dirty and/or wet clothes. *We will be cleaning daily to avoid the spreading of germs.*

If you become sick please visit the Nurses Station or SHRMP headquarters immediately.

Dress appropriately from time you arrive until you return home. Youth leaders should take responsibility for ensuring these dress codes are met by everyone. Individuals not meeting these requirements may be asked to change into appropriate clothing to accomodate dress codes for entire SHRMP Team.

**SHRMP Dress Code is for all youth and adults to follow. Each participant is required to sign the Dress Code Covenant.**

- **NO** spaghetti strap shirts, tops or dresses allowed, *however an appropriate top worn under a sleeveless sun dress or jumper is acceptable.*
- **NO** Short tops that can't be tucked in. See threw or sheer tops are also not allowed.
- **NO** Dresses or blouses with a low-cut front or back. Showing of cleavage is not permitted.
- **NO** Clothing or any other items which may be offensive to our Christian testimony (*shirts with beer or cigarette ads, rock groups, suggestive phrases, or anything which would be a poor testimony are not permitted*). This includes bandanas and wearing of any type of clothing containing confederate emblems.
- **MANDATORY that ALL shorts have at least a 6 inch inseam. No Exception.** (*FYI: Boys basketball shorts and boys soccer shorts have longer inseams*)
- **NO** Leggings or Yoga Pants. These are not considered suitable for mission work.
- **Guys:** Shirts must be worn at all times. Tank top tee shirts or "wife beater" tee shirts are not allowed. (*Girls too in case you are asking*)
- **Guys are NOT to slouch their pants.** If your pants won't stay up...get a belt. If needed, duct tape and/or zip ties are available. At no time should your under layer(s) be visable.
- In the event permission is granted to the use of a pool: Keep all swimsuits modest. *Dark shirts may be worn over swimsuits.* Bikinis, suits with French-cut legs, or revealing one-piece swimsuits should be avoided. Skimpy swim trunks for guys are not allowed.
- **SHRMP T-Shirts** must be worn whenever on Sites or Outings
- You may **not alter** your **SHRMP t-shirt** with scissors, markers or tie up during SHRMP week. Shirts that have been altered may result in individual remaining at church and not participating on sites. This may also prevent shirts from be washed with group to avoid others being stained.
- **SHRMP t-shirts** are washed nightly by outside volunteers. Make sure each participants name is written on the inside neckline clearly to identify his/her shirt. Sharpies will be provided for this.
- Please wear comfortable shoes. You will be on your feet most of the day.
